

DO NOT FEAR!

Music Time Mission Friends for Prek/K Spring 2020

ACTIVITIES AND THINGS TO DO:

- Listen to the music while your child eats or plays.
- Make a movement stick. Use a paper towel roll or any stick object you have and let kids color or paint the tube/stick. Use streamers, curling ribbon, crepe paper or string to tie or tape at the end of stick. Listen to #1 DO NOT FEAR. Let children move and sing to the song.
- Make up sign motions to go with songs. Let children make them up or look up a few American sign language signs (not every word!)
Example : God Helps Me, I Will Not Be AfraidGOD-Point up for God, HELPS -thumbs up with right hand sitting on flat left palm moving both upward, ME- point to yourself, I WILL NOT- cross arms in a big not or use baseball "safe" sign. AFRAID – put both hands up to face like you are biting your fingernails. Whatever you come up with will be great!
- Make a musical instrument out of empty jar, can, bottle. Add rice or beans or small rocks to make it a shaker. Use pots pans and wooden spoons for drums. A box of macaroni makes a great shaker instrument also. Let child/ children plan instrument with a song –especially a fast one. Encourage them to stay on beat.
- Use a small stuffed animal to keep the beat of a song. We call these beat buddies at choir. They can be bounced to the beat on knees, arms head, really any part of the body.
- LEARN THE MEMORY VERSE:
Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified, for the LORD your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Deuteronomy 31:6
- READ Bible Stories together of Bible characters being brave or trusting God.
EX: Noah, Joshua, Daniel, Ruth & Naomi ,Ester, Mary, Paul
